



# 2019 Riley County Invitational 4-H Dog Bowl



**What:** The Riley County 4-H Kennel Club is hosting an invitational Dog Quiz Bowl for Children Ages 7-18

**When:** March 9<sup>th</sup>, 2019 – Check in starts at 8:30 am – the first round of competition starts at 9:00 am

**Where:** Pottorf Hall – Manhattan, KS

**Registration:** Registration closes on March 1<sup>st</sup>. **The number of teams may be limited and priority will be given on the order in which registrations are received.** Registration forms should be emailed to [ottoranch@gmail.com](mailto:ottoranch@gmail.com)

**Entry Fee:** \$5 per team. Checks should be made out to: Riley County 4H Kennel Club and paid **during Check In** on March 9<sup>th</sup>.

## Rules:

1. Teams will consist of two members between the ages of 7 and 18 (unlike the state Dog Quiz Bowl which has teams of 4)
2. A Moderator will ask participants questions. All decisions of the moderator are final. If participants would like clarification on an answer, they may inquire after the match.
3. There will be no True/False or Yes/No Questions
4. Some questions might be reused from previous Riley County or State Quiz Bowls
5. Buzzers:
  - a. The first person who activates the buzzer must begin the answer within 5 seconds of being recognized by the moderator.
  - b. If the question is not answered correctly, the opposing team will have the opportunity to answer the question. It will be re-read and they will have 5 seconds. They will still have to activate the buzzer to be recognized.
  - c. Questions will be read once per team
  - d. The team with the correct answer will be awarded one point.
  - e. The first answer will be taken on all questions.
  - f. If no buzzer is activated within 10 seconds, the moderator will give the answer and withdraw the question.
  - g. If someone activates a buzzer before the answer is completed, the moderator will stop at once and ask for the answer. If an incorrect answer is given, the other team will be read the complete question.
6. Matches:
  - a. Matches will consist of 16 questions per round with two rounds per match
  - b. The first round of each match will have 16 “One on One” questions (for specific chairs). Questions in the second round of each match will be asked in the “Free for All” format used at the Kansas Dog Quiz Bowl.
  - c. In the case of a tie, additional questions will be asked until the tie is broken.
  - d. Once a team has lost a match, it is eliminated from the competition.
7. Contestants cannot ask moderator any questions except to have the question re-read if they are the opposing team.
8. No audio or video recording is allowed.
9. All contestants will be in an isolation room until the team has been eliminated from competition. Parents/Coaches/Friends may be in isolation room with contestants or may watch the competition but are not allowed in the isolation room after competition has begun.
