

River Valley District – Clay County 4-H Scholarship(s) Application

Viola Bauer 4-H Scholarship

This scholarship has been established for Clay County 4-H members in honor of Viola Bauer, Community Leader for the Peppy 4-H Club (4-Mile school area). She was the first leader of the club that was organized in the fall of 1930. This annual scholarship is provided by her daughter, Violet Bauer Lindon.

The scholarship includes these items and requirements:

\$750.00 scholarship is to be used at Kansas State University.

Any Clay County 4-H member is eligible if the following are met:

- I. Must be a member of a Clay County 4-H club.
- II. Must be an active 4-H member the Sophomore, Junior & Senior year in High School.
- III. Must be at least a Senior in High School to apply.
- IV. One scholarship will be awarded per year.

Must submit a picture with the application

Can be awarded up to the time the 4-Her is classified as a Senior at Kansas State University (This would let any Junior College transfer eligible).

May be awarded more than once to the same person if that person qualifies and is selected.

Selection will be made by the Clay County 4-H & Youth Program Development Committee.

Funds will be administrated by the Kansas 4-H Foundation.

The first scholarship was awarded in September 1983.

The Clay County 4-H & Youth Program Development Committee will make all future changes in amounts, number of scholarships, etc., if the scholarship fund increases or decreases in size and earnings.

Clay County 4-H Development Fund Scholarship

This scholarship has been established for Clay County 4-H members by the Clay County 4-H Development Fund. This annual scholarship is provided by donations from those supporting our Clay County 4-Hers through donations to the Clay County 4-H Development Fund.

The scholarship includes these requirements.

1. The committee will make decisions in amounts and number of scholarship awarded annually
2. Any Clay County 4-H member is eligible if the following are met.
 - A. Must be a member of a County 4-H Club
 - B. Must be an active 4-H member their sophomore, junior and senior year in high school to apply or can be awarded up to the time the 4-Her is classified as a senior in college. An active 4-H member must attend 4-H Club and/or junior leader meetings from October 1 to the end of March of the current year.
3. Must submit a picture with the application.
4. May be awarded more than once to the same person if that person qualifies and is selected.
5. Selection will be made by the Clay County 4-H Development Fund.
6. Funds will be administered by the Clay County 4-H Development Fund.
7. Applications may be picked up at the River Valley Extension District Office in Clay Center and returned by the scholarship application deadline.
9. The Clay County 4-H Development Committee will make all future changes in amounts, number of scholarship etc., if scholarship fund increases or decreases in size and earning.
10. A 4-Her may apply for the Viola Bauer, the 4-H Development Fund Scholarship, and the Rundle Scholarship simultaneously.
11. Scholarship winners may pick up the scholarship money at the River Valley Extension District Office in Clay Center after you have enrolled for the fall semester.

Rundle Scholarship

Lois Rundle established this fund at the Kansas 4-H Foundation to provide annual college scholarships for up to three (3) Clay County Kansas 4-H or FFA members or alumni in the amount of \$1500 (or more, based on annual earnings; not to exceed \$2000 per scholarship).

Selection will be based on record of 4-H participation and achievement in 4-H activities. Evidence of leadership and excellence of personal involvement in 4-H will be a high priority. As requested by the donor, students of “average scholastic ability” will be given equal consideration to those of “superior scholastic ability.”

The scholarship may be used for any level of coursework from an accredited institution (including a community college or a vocational technical institution) and may be awarded to a previous recipient as long as eligibility requirements are met. Evidence of leadership and excellence of personal involvement in 4-H will be a high priority.

The following are the specific requirements for the awarding of the scholarship.

1. Resident of Clay County, Kansas,
2. Member of a Clay County Kansas 4-H project or community club or a Clay County FFA chapter for 3 of the 5 years immediately preceding the date of the scholarship application,
3. Member in good standing (per county 4-H Council), including compliance with record book requirements of 4-H membership,
4. Successful completion of high school education or the equivalent, and
5. Proof of full-time enrollment at an accredited institution

The Scholarship committee, (consisting of an Extension Agent with 4-H responsibilities in Clay County, a CCCHS Ag Teacher & FFA Advisor, and an Extension Board member representing Clay County), has the ability to determine the amounts of the scholarship(s) awarded (up to \$2000 per scholarship) based on the following criteria:

1. financial need of the applicant for educational funds;
2. type and expense of the curriculum to be pursued by the applicant; and
3. desire of the applicant to further his or her education.

Previous recipients are eligible to apply and receive the scholarship in subsequent years.
