Thirty-four responses to survey questions

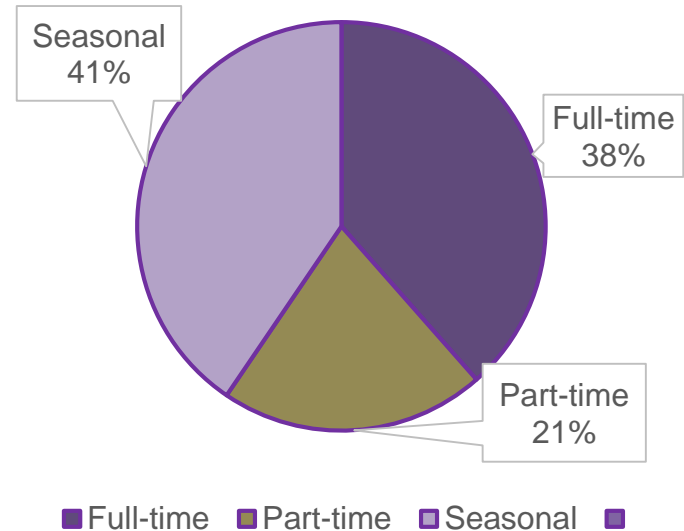
Questions asked:
