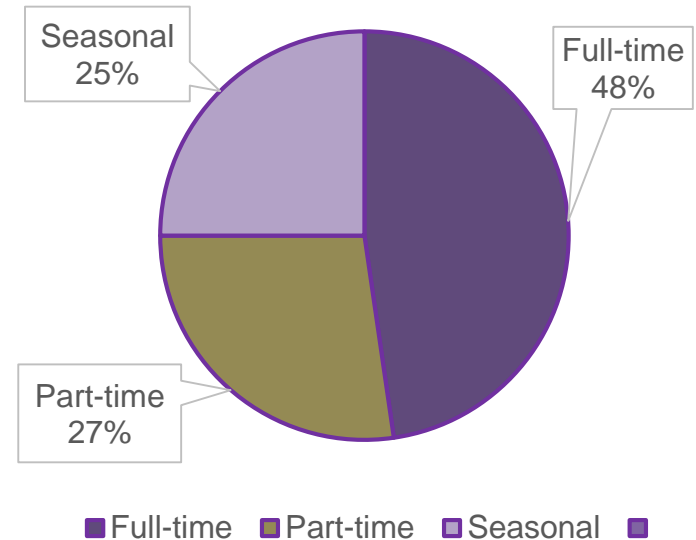
Status of Farm Labor
