Kansas Farm Management Summary Meeting April 29th in Clay Center

The River Valley Extension District will host a North Central Kansas Farm Management Association Summary Meeting on Monday, April 29th beginning at 6:00 p.m. at the 4-H Conference Center located on the Clay County Fairgrounds.

The Kansas Farm Management Association (KFMA) economist will present a regional summary of the 2018 KFMA data. This data is often helpful for producers, ag lenders, and farm managers as a comparison as they analyze their farm performance measures and prepare budgets for the upcoming seasons. The economist will also present information on PLC vs. ARC Past, Present, and Future. In addition, the agents of the River Valley District will present: *Weathering the Storm – Managing Farm Stress*.
