Defensive Driving Class

K-State Research and Extension's River Valley District is offering a Defensive Driving Class. This class will assist in sharpening your driving skills, may help prevent an accident from happening, and may lower your auto insurance premium. The class will be held on Tuesday, September 29th, from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. at our Clay Center Office (322 Grant Ave). There is a \$20 registration fee per person to pay for materials. Registration and payment are due by Tuesday, September 22nd. A minimum of 15 people are required to sign up in order to have the class.

Many defensive driving tips will be presented by Trooper Ben Gardner from the Kansas Highway Patrol. The Defensive Driving Class will be completed in one day and snacks will be provided at breaks. Those attending can bring their lunch with refrigeration available or go out for an hour lunch. Participants do not drive or take a test. Insurance companies recognize the benefits of defensive driving classes and many provide a 5-10% premium discount to graduates of this course. The certificate received is effective for three years.

Social distancing will be practiced and masks will be required throughout the Defensive Driving Class.
