
FAIR THEME

The life skills (leadership, ownership, independence, and more) that 4-H'ers gain through the experiences are far more important than the color of a ribbon!



READ YOUR FAIR BOOK

If you haven't already, read your fair book. To avoid any errors or misunderstandings, it's highly encouraged to thoroughly read the fair book, including ALL general rules, plus the rules and regulations for the divisions your family will be participating in at the fair. We do not want you to be counted down on something that you missed.

ENTRIES AND SCHEDULE

If you need to scratch any of your entries, or have any questions please let the Extension Office know as soon as possible. The Extension Office phone number is 785-527-5084.

Some judging times may be tight but please don't panic. We will work with youth and families to ensure judging is completed.

The scheduled judging times may run early or late. These are just estimated times so please be patient. Please be early to scheduled judging times in case they are running ahead but be courteous if judging times are running behind. Everyone is doing their best to make fair successful.

FAIR OFFICE INFORMATION

PRE-FAIR CLEAN UP

We will move, clean, and set up display cases in the 4-H Building after Pre-Fair judging on Wednesday, July 23rd at 6:30 p.m. We will also be cleaning the barns this same evening, so bring brooms and rakes.

Each club needs to provide at least two youth and two adults. If more people would like to assist, they are always welcome.

FAIR ETIQUETTE

We ask that there are no bikes in any of the livestock barns. Please be considerate when riding a bike around the fairgrounds as it can be dangerous, so slow down and watch for people walking and your surroundings. If concerns continue, bikes will be banned from the fairgrounds. Just a friendly reminder our fairbook states no dogs in the livestock barns with the exception of a service dog.

VOLUNTEERING AT THE FAIR Volunteers are essential for the 4-H Division at the NCK Free Fair.

We need Junior Leaders (4-H age 12-18) and Adults to sign up for the times/projects they are interested in volunteering at. If you don't sign up, we may assign you a responsibility. If you have already signed up, please double check the times as we had to make adjustments when we hired additional judges.



PHOTO MOUNTING



There is only a floor buyer for sheep and goats. If you have extra sheep or goats to be sold at the floor bid, there is an additional form that is due at the time listed above. There is not a swine or beef floor buyer. 4-H families are responsible for marketing their own animals.

VESPERS SERVICE

The Vespers Service is a non-denominational worship service held on Sunday, August 3rd at 8:00 am at the Entertainment Center. All other activities on the fairgrounds are to cease during this time. The First United Methodist Church of Belleville will be providing the service this year. Please join us for the service, donuts, milk, and juice.

EXHIBIT CHECK-OUT

All exhibits, including livestock, will be released following the Vespers Service on Sunday, August 3^{rd} between 8:30 am - 10:00 am. 4-H'ers and families must pick up all exhibits during this time. At least, two 4-H members and two adults from each club must be present to assist with cleaning up and storing away the display cases.

On Sunday, August 3rd, animals sold to the Floor Buyer will be loaded out. Either the 4-H'er or parent/guardian should be present to assist with this process. Trailers to local lockers may be available if you have pre-scheduled appointments. This may be shared during the mandatory livestock meetings or check with your superintendent.

You **MUST** clean out all animal pens before leaving the fairgrounds or you forfeit your ribbon premiums.

Eligible Entries

We will transport items to KSF if not too large or fragile (no animals). Please highlight which projects you would like to enter in the Kansas State Fair. Also, please cross out any projects that you will not be entering.



Wednesday, August 6th is the last day to let us know about KSF entries. During fair checkout, you may complete the supplied photo release slips and leave your photography entries with staff.
